Day One 9:00am - 5:00pm

In the relaxed working environment of an artists studio you will experience a day which will stimulate and challenge. A mixed day of rational theory and creative hands on sessions.

Theory and Discussion

We will be taking a scientific approach to exploring the intangible side of our Creative Intelligence – the mind and the heart. It is about understanding the duality of our nature, breaking through old mindsets and limitations and creating the future which aligns to our values.

Life Drawing

Through the all seeing eyes of your Observer self, you will be drawing from a life model (professional nude model). This exercise will enable you to truly "see" and not just "look" and has the potential for you to identify opportunities previously unrecognised. It will also stimulate your creative nature through the process of "allowing" the emergence of congruent solutions.

Day Two 9:00 – 5:00pm Artists Studio

Day two is focussed on the more tangible aspects of being creative and innovative. You will be working with reconfiguring objects and creating new ideas. The intention behind this work is to break down your assumptions and begin to intersect ideas through design and reconfiguration of objects.

A guest speaker will discuss what it takes to create a culture of innovation in the workplace.

To cap the seminar off, you will also be introduced to the secrets to investing in art from Art Consultant, Russell Unnit.
